- NFIB Young Entrepreneur Award**-This award was established to recognize seniors who have demonstrated outstanding entrepreneurial spirit and initiative. Eligibility requirements include:

 - Current high school seniors planning to enroll in college in the fall of 2008
 - Demonstration of entrepreneurial initiative as evidenced by: operation of his or her own small business; participation in organizations such as DECA, FBLA, or Junior Achievement or other initiative (web-page design, long-term lawn care work, etc.)

- Toyota Community Scholars Award**-This award is designed to recognize a senior who has demonstrated exceptional community service in and out of the school setting. Academic performance will also be considered, but the main identifying factor will be essential service to a community or school need. Leesville can nominate one senior for this award. Interested seniors should submit a resume to Mr. Greene by December 10, 2007. The resume must be in the format of the resume listed in the senior planning guide.
- McKelvey Foundation Young Entrepreneur Scholarship**- This scholarship is available to all high school seniors who have demonstrated entrepreneurial spirit by owning and operating their own businesses while in high school. Further criteria and the application to apply can be found at www.mckelveyfoundation.org The deadline to apply is January 15, 2008.
- Robert C. Byrd Scholarship**-This federally funded scholarship is for any senior who is graduating from a North Carolina High School, is a U. S. Citizen, and plans to enroll full-time at a college in the fall. Applicants must have at least a minimum 1875 total on the SAT, and a minimum of a 3.5 unweighted GPA. Leesville can only submit five applicants for this award. Interested seniors should submit a resume to Mr. Greene by December 20, 2007. When turning in your resume, please indicate which scholarship it is for.
- Sam Walton Community Scholarship**- This \$1000 scholarship is for the first year of college for a graduating senior. To apply, you cannot be an employee or be the son or daughter of employee of Sam's Club or Wal-Mart. To apply, go to www.walmartfoundation.org. The deadline to apply is January 14, 2008.
